Sealed Tenders under two bid system (Technical & Price Bid) are invited from competent & experienced Contractors to provide catering services for preparation and supply of cooked food/tea etc. round the clock in our factory premises at Kanagala – 591 225, Tq. Hukkeri, Dist. Belgaum for a period of **12 Months, which is extendable for 12 more months based on the performance and requirement** from the date of work order.

A Pre-Bid meeting will be held at our office on the date mentioned below. Interested parties may attend the meeting and clarify their doubts. HLL shall explain the details of contract. The Minutes of Pre-Bid meeting shall be treated as part of Tender document and it will be binding on all the bidders, who submit the Tender.

Blank Tender forms (Technical Bid and price Bid) may be collected in person from our office at Kanagala on any working day OR can be downloaded from our website [www.lifecarehll.com](http://www.lifecarehll.com) at Free of Cost. The completed tenders duly superscribed along with E.M.D. of Rs.15,000/- by D.D. drawn in favour of HLL Life care Ltd., payable at SBI, Nipani-591237 should reach to us on or before due date for submission.

Tenders submitted after the due date will not be considered. The Management reserves the right to accept or reject any tender at any stage without assigning any reason and also to negotiate with the lowest quoted party and the same will be binding on all the tenderers. If the Tenderer/s back out from the commitment, their EMD will be forfeited followed by Blacklisting. The tenderers should be ready to attend negotiation meeting at their own cost at Kanagala OR at the place as fixed by the Company.

**Annexure-A**

**1. Minimum Eligibility criteria for qualifying.**

- The Tenderer should have minimum two years experience in running Industrial Canteen or Public Canteen, however preference will be given to contractor who is having experience in Industrial Canteen.
- 1.1 The Tenderer should have valid Food license and submit a copy along with the tender.
- 1.2 The Tenderer should have valid PAN number and GST registration number.

**2. Company will provide:**

- I. Canteen Building free of rent, Free Electricity, Free water, Tables and Chairs.
- II. Required Utensils, Gas Stoves/Burners.
- III. HLL shall give a subsidy of Rs.30,000/- Per month OR actual cost of the LPG gas whichever is lower. The contractor need to submit the proof of payments made to the suppliers.
- IV. Free Firewood or Charcoal if required/Cost of fire wood /Charcoal will be reimbursed on monthly basis
- V. Liquid soap for hand wash and Phenyl & Nirma /Surf/Vim for floor cleaning as per norms fixed by us. (Incase any extra materials are required the contractor has to arrange at his own cost).
- VI. HLL shall pay an amount of Rs.45,000/- Per Month as Canteen maintenance charges to the contractor.

**3. Financial Implications (Approx):**

The canteen contractor is eligible for the following reimbursements per month.

- I. The contractor should issue the coupons to each employee as per the eligibility of each employee and as decided by the company. The cost of the coupons issued to the employees shall be reimbursed on monthly basis.
- II. Reimbursement of Cost of Firewood/Coal for the actual quality consumed each month against your claim with necessary documents.
- III. Reimbursement of expenses towards preparing and serving of Tea/Coffee/Milk, Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, Cold Drinks, Special Food Items etc. to Company Guests or at the Training Sessions or on any other Occasions on monthly basis at actual, against submission of the claim duly certified by concerned controlling officers.
- IV. Reimbursement of cost of Tea served to our employees during Night Shift, against submission of the claim with necessary documents.

**4. Procedure for deciding L1 party.**

Approximate quantities per month are mentioned against the major items. The rates quoted shall be multiplied with the quantities and the overall monthly financial commitment will be worked out. The L1 party shall be decided based on the overall monthly financial commitment. Only the L1 party shall be called for further negotiations.

**Annexure-B**

**Instruction to Bidders & General Terms and Conditions.**

1. This is a two bid system comprising of (a) Technical bid & (b) Price bid
2. The Technical Bid should accompany a D.D for Rs.15000/- towards Earnest Money Deposit drawn in favour of **HLL Lifecare Ltd.**, and payable at Nipani-591237 failing which the Tender will summarily be rejected.
3. Both the Bids shall be submitted in sealed covers separately. Tender numbers of the Technical and Price Bids shall be superscribed on the respective covers in order to clearly identify between the two Bids. The two separately sealed and superscribed Bids enclosed in a single cover and superscribed with the respective Tender No. Complete in all respects, addressed to the Unit Chief, HLL Life Care Ltd., Kanagala-591225 should reach us on or before the due date and time mentioned in the Tender Notification. HLL Lifecare Ltd., shall not be responsible for any delay, if any, in the delivery of the bidding documents or non-receipt of the same.
4. Section 101(Exemption of occupier or Manager from liability) of chapter X under the Factories Act 1948(All LXIII of 1948) (23<sup>rd</sup> sept 1948) is applicable
5. Payment will be released on monthly basis.
6. Taxes & duties if applicable are to be borne by the contractor only.
7. The contractor will have to submit an affidavit at the time of signing the agreement indicating that all employees of the contractor are paid the minimum wage as per Minimum Wages Act.
8. Preferably Contractor should have independent PAN number and GST registration allotted by the concerned authorities (if required). The contractor will be solely and exclusively responsible to adhere to meet out all statutory obligations under Indian law in respect of compliance of all the rules, regulations and directions given by a statutory authority with regard to safety, labour laws, minimum wages, PF&ESI remittance or any other prevalent laws both of Central and State Enactments.

9. Contractor will comply with all the statutory norms including hours of work and Holidays / Rest etc.
10. The contractor shall also submit a **medical certificate** on half yearly basis that all his/her employees handling food are not having any contagious diseases.
11. The Contractor should take license under the **Contract Labour (R & A) Act 1970** & other statutory licenses if any before commencement of work and should be produced, if required.
12. Work is to be carried out strictly as per the schedule and any change in the mode of work if desired by HLL is to be implemented and the contractor shall supervise the work.
13. HLL Lifecare Ltd. has no obligation with regard to statutory and other welfare measures for the workmen employed by the contractor for the said contract.
14. The contractor will ensure that his/her employees handling food at all times use neat and clean clothes, aprons, masks & caps . Every employee so appointed by the contractor shall wear the prescribed uniform. The contractor at his own cost shall provide the said uniform.
15. HLL reserves the right to ask & require the contractor to remove any person deployed by the contractor without assigning any reason or notice.
16. The contractor will ensure high standard of cleanliness, hygiene and sanitation in the kitchen and canteen. The contractor will make the arrangements for keeping all eatables in covered showcase, free from flies and insects. The contractor has to ensure proper disposal of garbage will provide adequate number of dustbins. There should not be any littering of unused food or any other articles within the canteen. The contractor will also ensure that no used utensils viz Cups, Thales are lying in the HLL campus and these should be removed immediately. For Preparation of the food items, only sunflower refined oil is to be used.
17. Experienced cook only should carry out cooking. The contractor will have to ensure that the cooks have proper shave and clipped nails while cooking food and should wear apron and head gear.
18. The contractor will have to ensure that the cooked and uncooked food is stored properly and no stale food is served. In case of any food poisoning, the contractor will be held solely responsible and will be penalized besides legal action.
19. HLL officials can check the raw materials used for cooking at any time and if substandard / unauthorized materials are found, the contractor will be

penalized at the discretion of HLL and contractor will have to abide by it. The penalty will include at least Rs.1,000/- in case if it is found using sub standard material.

20. In the event of unsatisfactory services rendered by the contractor, the contract may be cancelled by the HLL by giving one month's notice. In case the contractor is having any difficulty to continue the contract he should give a two-month notice in writing to HLL for short closing the contract. In case the contract is short closed HLL may forfeit the Security deposit / levy penalty as decided by the HLL authority.
21. The contractor should supply the items to employees / staff against coupons / cash only. No responsibility will be taken by the HLL for credit sales to staff, employees and others, losses or pilferage.
22. No legal right shall vest in the contractor's workers to claim employment or otherwise absorption in HLL nor the contractor's workers shall have any right whatsoever to claim the benefit and/or emoluments that may be permissible or paid to the employees of HLL. The workers will remain the employees of the contractor and this should be the sole responsibility of the contractor to make it clear to his/her workers before deputing them to work at HLL.
23. The contractor shall not engage the services of any sub contractor or transfer the contract to any other person. If, it is found at any time that the contractor is unable to provide the canteen services and has sub contracted to any other party, HLL has right to terminate the contract and to forfeit all security deposits by giving one months notice.
24. The total HLL Campus is 'NO SMOKING ZONE' . Smoking, chewing tobacco / pan masala, consuming liquor etc is strictly prohibited inside the premises. Violation of the same shall attract a penalty up to Rs.5000/- for each instance. Such penalty shall be recovered from the contractor's Bills.
25. HLL Lifecare Limited will not be liable for any accident happened to Contractors' workmen while on work during the contract period. The contractor has to buy **personal accident insurance / contractor all risk policy (CAR policy)** in respect of the employees deployed by him as per the Payment of Workmen compensation Act. Contractor shall ensure Personal Accident Insurance (24X7) policy of contract workers. The coverage shall be of Rs. 5 Lakhs per individual. The coverage shall be of 24 Hrs. (Accident Death cover). The sum assured (Rs. 5 Lakhs) shall become payable to the nominee in the event of death of insured person. In the event of death of any contract worker deployed by the contractor without proper insurance cover, the contractor shall be liable to pay Rs. 5 Lakhs to the nominee / legal heir of such deceased contract worker.

26. On award of the contract, the contractor has to deposit an amount of Rs. **50,000/- towards Security Deposit**, which will be refunded by cheque without any interest on satisfactory Completion of the contract.
27. In case of any damages caused to HLL property by contractor / his men while executing the job, the cost of the same shall be recovered from the contractor.
28. The rates quoted should be valid till the completion of contract and will not be enhanced during the period of the contract on any account. Sub contract is not allowed.
29. The contractor is bound to follow the suggestion/instruction given by the authorized persons of HLL Lifecare Limited / canteen committee.
30. The Contractor has to ensure that all precautions are taken for safety of his employees and equipments.
31. Entries to the Kitchen should be restricted and the employees working at kitchen should not use the street foot wares / shoes inside the kitchen. Separate foot wares for kitchen use are to be provided by the contractor, at his own cost.
32. Minor repair works of Burners, Stoves, Mixers, Fridge etc. to be get done by the contractor himself at his own cost.
33. Contractor shall decide the number of employees to be deployed for execution of the work awarded to him and he or his authorized representative solely entitled to instruct such workers about the manner of carrying out the work as per the prescribed specifications and quality plan. However, any day the number of technological Man hour should not be less than 96 including supervisor man hour to execute the day to day work.
34. Contractor to ensure that the employees deployed in the premises of HLL are physically and mentally fit and do not have any criminal record. Such employees should posses requisite skill, proficiency, qualification & experience etc. acceptable to concerned department.
35. The contractor shall arrange for the **Medical check up** of his employees and produce the fitness certificate from the authorized hospital/Doctor before reporting for the work. Contractor shall arrange routine Medical checkup for his employees every six months & reports needs to be submitted to HR department.
36. It is the contractor responsibility for the safety aspects of his employees deployed for the work. He should provide necessary safety equipments like Shoes, Gloves, and Mask etc at his own cost to his employees deployed for

the said work wherever necessary. The safety & quality policy of the Company shall be complied by the contractor

37. The company HLL Lifecare Ltd. reserves the right to cancel the contract at any time during the contract period without paying any compensation and the decision of the HLL Lifecare Ltd. with regard to termination of contractual provision will be final. In the event of contractor abandoning the work OR HLL revoking the contract HLL reserves the right to get incomplete work completed at contractor's RISK & COST. HLL shall have a right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
38. Season wise available Fruits like Banana, Apple, Grapes, Mangoes, Chikku etc are to be made available at par with market rates.
39. Cold Drinks, flavored milk & ready made Snacks, Biscuits, Chocolates etc also required to be kept in the Canteen for Sale at M.R.P
40. Any other Veg/ Non-Vegetarian dishes not reflected in the list are to be prepared in demand for which advance intimation will be given and reasonable rate to be charged.
41. The quoted rates should be inclusive of Taxes, as applicable.
42. Tea with light snack like Bhaji / bhadang / donut / bun etc. etc should be served at the work spot inside factory and Office two times in a day.
43. **Night Tea should be served inside factory at about 11 to 11.30 PM in night.** To facilitate the same you should have sufficient manpower for serving. Details of the Tea serving timings and location can be confirmed with HR department.
44. Contractor shall indemnify HLL against all claims by statutory authorities & losses under various labour laws, statutes OR any civil or criminal law in connection with the employees employed by him.
45. The contractor shall liable to pay statutory Bonus under payment of Bonus Act 1965 and submit proof of disbursement along with received copy of Form –D
46. The contractor shall responsible for the discipline of his own laborers deployed under the service contract. In case of any loss to HLL on account of indiscipline of contract labour then such loss shall be assessed & recovered from the contractor's Bills or from the security Deposit.
47. The contractor shall not employ any person who has not completed his 18 years of age & person who attained 60 year of age.

**48. LEAVE WITH WAGE TO THE CONTRACT LABOUR.**

The contractor shall make provisions of the leave with wages as per the Govt. Act. And it should be strictly observed. The quoted rates should include the cost of such provisions and HLL will not do any additional payments towards such provisions.

**49. LEGAL COMPLIANCE**

The Contractor will comply with all the provisions regarding licensing, welfare & health procedures, maintenance of various records & registers etc. as provided under the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act 1970, rules amendments, orders, notifications there under issued by the Appropriate Govt. from time to time. For non-compliance of any provisions, statutory compliances under law, the contractor shall be responsible for penalties levied by the appropriate authorities under the Act. The contractor shall also be liable to comply with all other labour & Industrial Laws and such other Act, payment of Bonus Act, Minimum Wages Act etc. Depositing ESI, PF Contributions as may be applicable is the responsibility of the contractor for any default in compliance the contractor shall be held responsible.

50. The contractor shall make good all damage/loss which may be caused by any act or default of the contractor, his agents or servants or workers to any property of the Institute HLL reserves the option to make good the damage or loss by charging the contractor with the expenses.

51. Without prejudice to right under any other clause of the contract, the HLL may in the event any breach of the conditions on the part of the contractor cancel the contract and charge the contractor with any loss arising from such cancellation. Non satisfactory canteen service will be terminated without any notice & Security amount will be forfeited.

52. Dispute if any, arising out of the contract shall be settled by mutual discussion or arbitration by sole arbitrator to be appointed by HLL at Hukkeri Court as per the provisions of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules framed there under. Any Arbitrator appointed shall not have the jurisdictions to pass any interim awards, or to grant interest higher than 8% charged simply on the award amounts or amounts payable to either party. No dispute arising of the execution, implementation or termination of the present contract, as also any other dispute with respect to the present contract be entertained by any court and shall be subject matter of Arbitration under the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and rules framed there under.

53. All legal disputes shall be subject to jurisdiction of Hukkeri court (Belgaum Dist. Karnataka) only.



54. The contractor shall inform to the administration department of HLL Lifecare Kangala any changes of Canteen workers, if required, made by him along with their police verification and medical report.
55. The contractor shall submit duly signed undertaking enclosed with the tender document.
56. HLL Lifecare Limited will not be liable for any accident happened to contractors' workmen while on work during the contract period. The contractor has to buy EDLI if applicable & **personal accident insurance policy** in respect of the employees deployed by him as per the Payment of Workmen compensation Act.
