2. WARRANTY

CLARIFICATION TO BIDDERS

In case the bidder quotes partly indigenous items and partly imported items, the following clause for Delivery period shall be incorporated in the NoA:

For Indigenous Goods:

Goods must be delivered at consignee site on or before the delivery of imported goods (at consignee site). The date of delivery will be the date of receipt of goods at consignee site.
