#### 21. AWARD OF CONTRACT- AWARD CRITERIA

The contract will be awarded to the successful bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and as the lowest price offered by the bidder.

#### 22. ONTRACT AMENDMENTS

No variation in or modification of the terms of the Contract shall be made except by written amendment signed by the parties.

#### 23. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

- a) If the Supplier fails to deliver the Goods or to perform the Services within the period(s) specified in the Contract, the Purchaser shall, deduct liquidated damages from the Contract Price, a sum equivalent to the percentage of price of the delayed Goods or unperformed Services for each week or part thereof of delay until actual delivery or performance, up to a maximum deduction of the percentage as specified below.
- b) Liquidated Damage : Penalty shall be at the rate of 0.5% per week subject to a maximum of 7.5% of the total contract value for the delay beyond the agreed period. Once the maximum is reached, the Purchaser may consider termination of the Contract at cost of supplier.

#### 24. TERMINATION BY DEFAULT

- a. In case the Supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period specified in the LOI/PO or extension thereof or the Supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract, the Purchaser may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, terminate the Contract in whole or part;
- b. In the event the such termination, in whole or in part, the Purchaser may procure the Goods or Services similar to those undelivered, and the Supplier shall be liable to the Purchaser for any excess costs for such similar Goods/Services.

#### 25. FORCE MAJEURE

- a) For purposes of this Clause "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Supplier and not involving the Supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable.
